PARTNERSHIP OVERVIEW

The relationship between NS Optimum & Grove School began early in 2012 when we visited the school to discuss their upgrade. After the proposals were finalised, we set a date and installed the new network servers with our primary school management tools, core switches and a new set of NS Optimum Mini ITX PC's for the ICT Suite.

Following on from this our partnership has continued with the installation of **CCTV IP Surveillance** across the school, a school-wide **door entry system** with visitor access and the installation of more data cabling in the new receoption area development. The admin & curriculum networks are supported with **2 days per week NS Optimum Technician** service & 'Silver' onsite and **remote emergency support**.



TABLET DEPLOYMENT



In 2014 NS Optimum worked closely with Grove School on a project to deploy nearly **350 tablet devices** across the school. After much discussion the choice was made to purchase a combination of LearnPad Android tablets and iPads which NS Optimum supplied, configured, provided training to the staff and now support.



INTERACTIVE LED SCREEN ROLLOUT

With the core network being robust and reliable, Grove School looked at new ways to enhance the learning experience. In early spring 2014 the decision was made to swap out all existing SMARTboards in 28 classrooms and replace them with interactive LED screens.

NS Optimum advised Grove School on CleverTouch LED screens as they are not only robust & well built, but also include **software to integrate tablets** into the classroom under the control of the teacher. As the school were also embarking on a tablet deployment initiative, these screens were the perfect solution. By May 2014 all 28 classrooms had CleverTouch interactive screens installed by NS Optimum with **FREE training** given to all the staff.
